Once the Builder has produced the Word itinerary consultants are in normal Microsoft Word. From there they can manually make changes or add finishing touches before sending the itinerary to your client.

The pictures, text and layout can be customised to suit the specific needs of your company. This can for example include consultant names, itinerary start and end dates, number of days, agent names, logos or any other information that you might find important.
